What Will be Expected of You & **1** Your Family

You will be asked to invite a therapist to your home every day, usually after school. The therapist will work one-on-one with your child.

3 Where will "therapy" take place?

The person in charge of your child's program will set up a few different places in your home for learning!

5 Does this "cure" Autism?

Autism cannot be cured, stay away from any agency that promises a cure. ABA Therapy is focused on teaching your child important skills that will help them in their life journey

2 We have multiple children

Awesome! The person in charge of your child's program will help them learn with or without their siblings. What may be tricky is if your child's siblings have after-school groups.

4 How many hours?

When you get in touch with an ABA Therapy office, they will assign a Behavior Analyst. Together with your doctor's ABA Prescription, they will decide how many hours per week are needed.

6 Is ABA Therapy required?

No! It's elective and by choice, your choice.
